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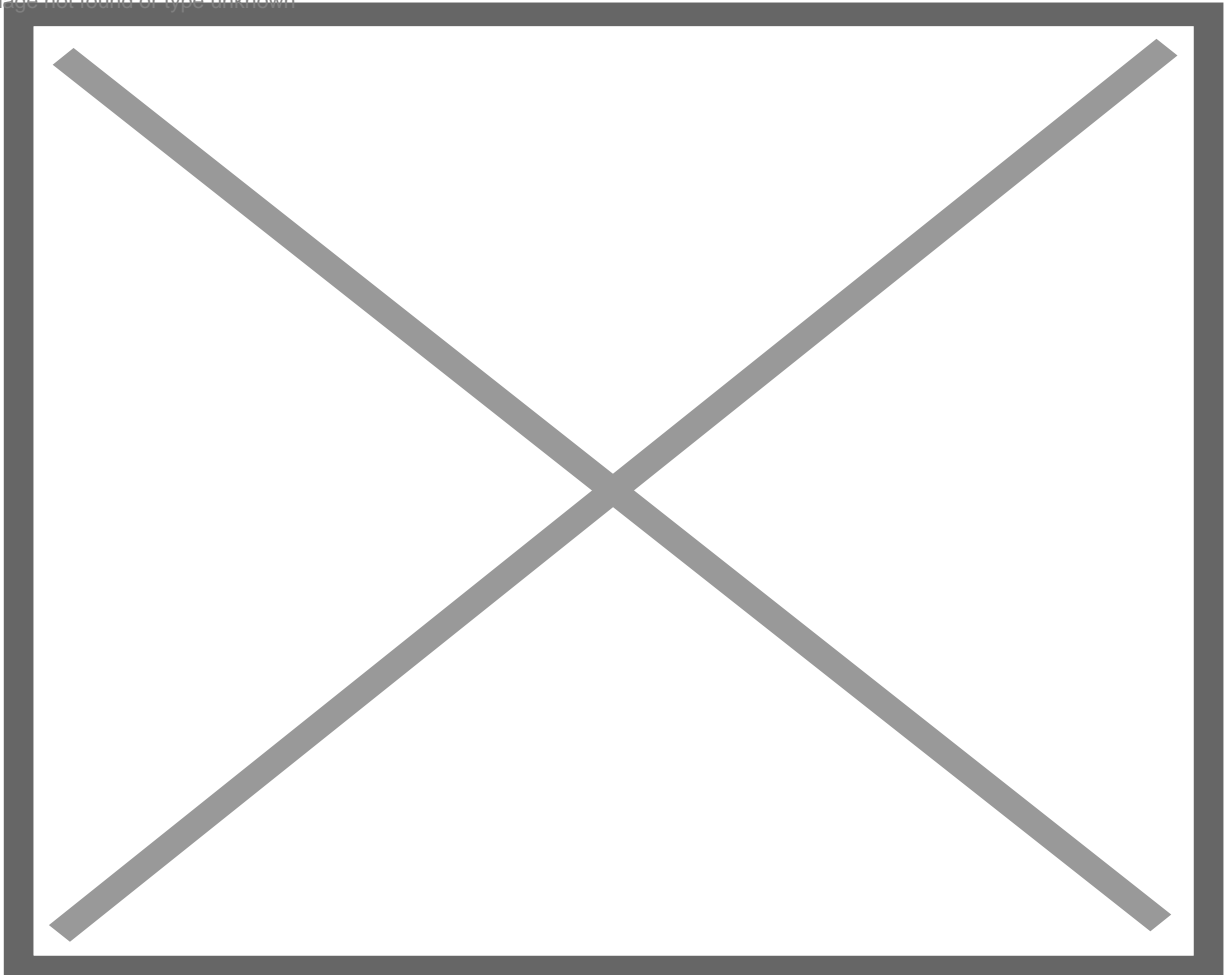
Link Up Lounge to Host ‘The Brand Lab’ on St. Croix, Blending Branding Insight With Live Entertainment
